



Current Vacancy: Hydrographic Surveyor

An opportunity exists for an experienced Hydrographic Surveyor to join the Precision Hydrographic Services (PHS) team in a full-time capacity.

Applicants must be certified at Level 1 through the Australasian Hydrographic Surveyors Certification Panel, and have over 5 years' experience specifically in hydrography projects for dredging and seabed mapping. Applicants must have experience with setting up vessels and infrastructure for dredge surveying projects to provide data to the highest standards. Experience with real-time acquisition to the ellipsoid and rapid data turn around is essential, along with your knowledge of dredging operations and survey requirements to support project outcomes. Applicants must have experience processing and interpreting bathymetric and other geophysical data sets at sea and on shore, deriving and integrating GIS and mapping products, visualising data and communicating the results in reports and papers.

We want to hear from you if you have a positive attitude and the ability to resolve problems using your initiative and lateral thinking. Good communication skills are a must, along with your high level of computer literacy. You will be directed by our Operations Manager to ensure the successful completion of survey tasks in accordance with PHS procedures and to our very high standards.
